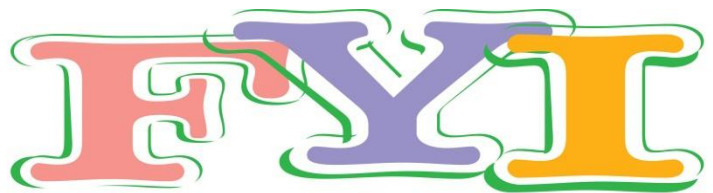
We would like to invite you to attend and join us in the annual event.
