Guidelines for showing art:



1. Any PoP member is welcome to show some of his/her art. Members are invited to send digital images to Larry Gross, worship arts chair. larrygross626@comcast.net
2. The Worship Arts team will review art monthly to schedule what art will be shown.
3. Art will be posted/hung on the wall for a month at a time, unless no new artist has been scheduled for exhibit.
4. Work need NOT be religious in subject. It is understood that art is a gift from God and worthy to be seen.
5. The wall is for exhibit only, NOT for selling one's works.
6. A pedestal will be furnished for artists exhibiting 3-dimensional work. (This needs careful consideration. Some 3-D work is vulnerable, e.g. ceramics)
7. If room permits, more than one piece may be exhibited by the artist who is scheduled for the given month.
