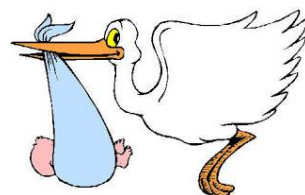
School's Out For The Summer!

Home Plate Volunteers Needed!



Did you ever wonder whether our support of HomePlate has a long-term impact in our community? Unlike downtown Portland, suburban

neighborhoods like ours do not have safety nets for people who are experiencing financial stress and homelessness. HomePlate is on the front lines of addressing this problem. It is Washington County's only non-profit provider of drop-in centers and street outreach for young people who are experiencing homelessness.

HomePlate strives to serve youth in their own community, rather than forcing them to go to downtown Portland. Research shows that service in the local community has a higher rate of success because it reduces the exposure of at-risk youths to 'street acculturation', prostitution, drug-culture, and other risk factors more prevalent in urban areas.
