HomePlate's team of outreach staff and volunteers travel Washington County four days a week, meeting youth where they are. They provide basic resources like water bottles, hygiene supplies, and referrals to other community partners. They visit transit centers, schools, and skate parks. They ride public transit—to find youth where they are and to provide help on the spot. Outreach workers carry green backpacks that are filled with resources to help ensure the health and safety of youth, and which are great ice-breakers. Outreach workers also give outreach cards to each interested person. These cards have information about HomePlate's drop-in meals, and how to contact outreach workers directly. Would you like to be on an outreach team? It requires a minimum commitment of weekly service for six months. Contact Jeff Oltmann.
