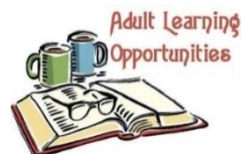

This month features another watercolor by Bill Anzur. Take a look at "Wild and Wary at Sunset". Nice work, Bill!

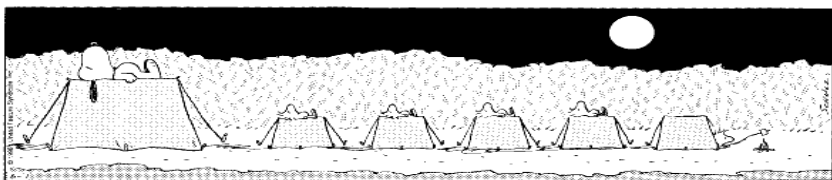
Adult Education Class:
