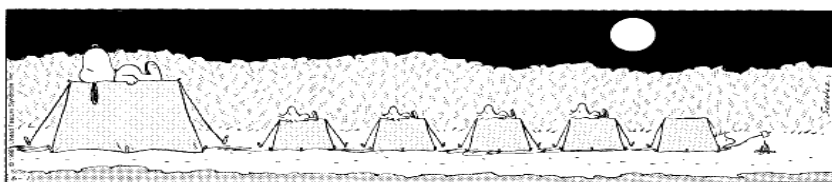
Prints & Pieces Art:
