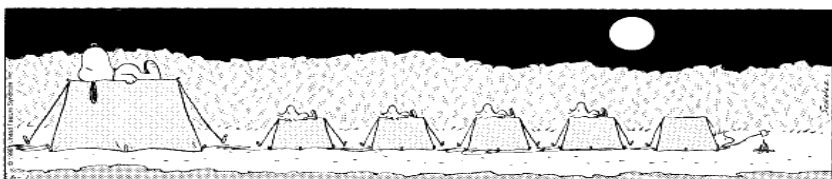

The outreach workers provide basic resources like water bottles, hygiene supplies, a listening ear, and assistance connecting with other sources of help.
